

NSS Unit-I of PVKN Govt. College (A), Chittoor conducted Special Camping Programme from 15th March 2022 to 21st March, 2022 at Mandal Parishad Primary School, P. Kothur village, Chittoor mandal. The adopted village, P. Kothur is situated 8 km north west of P.V.K.N Govt. College (A), Chittoor at the Kanipakam road. The camping area includes P. Kothur, P. Kothur Harijanawada and ST Colony covering a total of 160 households. Apart from the local youth, 46 student-volunteers have been participated in the camp. This camp was headed by Dr. G. Ananda Reddy, Principal, PVKN Govt. College (A), Chittoor. Dr. P. Bhanuprakash, NSS Programme Officer, Unit-I, PVKN Govt. College (A), Chittoor acted as camp officer.

NSS UNIT-I

The camp was organized with the main theme "Health, Public Sanitation and Personal Hygiene". Apart from learning how to serve the society, the objectives of organizing the NSS Special Camp was to develop the personality of the volunteers by inculcating the qualities like unity, discipline, honesty, self-confidence, character, cooperation, commitment, leadership etc. and enable them to adjust and adapt to various situations to comprehend problems prevailing in the community and to make them aware of the various resources available to deal with their problems.

For the purpose of effective management and organization of the special camp, the NSS volunteers were divided into five groups and were assigned various committees namely, Mess Committee, House-keeping Committee, Reception Committee, Programme Committee, and Project Execution Committee. Each day the groups were assigned a new committee. This ensured every volunteer to take an equal opportunity to perform a particular project activity. Duties were also assigned to each committee. They were as follows:

1. Mess committee

- To purchase groceries required for preparation of food.
- To prepare and serve the food.
- To provide water for drinking and cooking.
- To clean the utensils and dining area after cooking.

2. House-Keeping Committee:

- To clean the internal school premises and the accommodation area.
- To provide sufficient water for washrooms and maintain the washrooms hygienically.
- To dispose all the wastes.

3. Programme committee:

- To arrange the materials required for different NSS activities.
- To run the daily activities of the camp in a planned manner.
- To conduct guest lectures and invited talks with required arrangements.
- To introduce the speaker and propose vote of thanks.
- To maintain good attendance for the NSS activities.
- To organize games and cultural programmes.

4. Project committee:

- To complete the assigned project or activity.
- To take care of tools and equipments
- To photograph all the events
- To prepare detailed report on the camp activities.

5. Reception committee:

- To look after the guests visited for the NSS camp.
- To explain the details and activities of the camp to the guests.

They removed dead or dying branches, branches that rub each other and weak branches that overhang school rooms and sidewalks.

The afternoon session of the first day began with Swachh Bharat Pledge by the NSS volunteers in the adopted village. After the pledge, the NSS volunteers divided in to teams, cleared the bushes of unwanted weed plants, and cleaned around the compound walls of the school. They covered the pits on the road way to school with mud and levelled it. In the last session, NSS volunteers started a procession in the streets of the village to create awareness among the villagers about the ensuing special camping programme in the village for a period of one week. NSS Volunteers interacted with village people by visiting their houses and discussed about their needs and requirements. Village authorities welcomed the NSS team to their village and assured them all sorts of co-operation needed in making the special camp a grand success. Lastly, volunteers discussed about the activities to be undertaken for the next day in the camp with NSS programme officer. Volunteers sang the NSS song and concluded the first day by NSS clapping.

DAY-2 (16-03-2022)

In the second day of the camp, as a part of Swachh Bharat and Shramadanam Programme in P. Kothur village, NSS Volunteers as five teams went into the streets of the village and organized a cleanliness drive. Volunteers cleaned the village roads, removed the dust heaps and cleared the plastic left outs. They swept all the streets of the village with broom sticks and attempted to create awareness on Cleanliness and hygiene among villagers. NSS Volunteers cleaned the premises of overhead water tank and removed unwanted weeds. They cleaned inside the overhead water tank with liquid bleach. As a part of shramadanam, the surroundings of the temple in P. Kothur village were also cleaned by removing the weeds and grass.

In the post lunch session, Swachh Bharat and Shramadanam Programme was continued by the Volunteers in P. Kothur Harijanawada village. They cleaned all streets PVKN GC (A), CHITTOOR NSS UNIT-I

of the village, removed dust heaps, plastic and fallen leaves. The blocked sewage in the drainage canals of the streets has been cleared. Apart from the cleaning activity, door-door awareness on "Importance of sanitation and open defecation free" was given in P. Kothur Harijanawada. The volunteers briefed the village residents about contaminations from open defecation which not only leads to pollution of the ground water but also spreads diseases like diarrhoea and cholera.

Later, some teams involved in making of placards for the rally to be carried out and other teams involved in the transportation of saplings from the nursery to the camp area. Lastly, the volunteers discussed about the activities to be undertaken for the next day with the camp officer. Volunteers sang the NSS song and concluded the day by NSS clapping.

DAY-3 (17-03-2022)

The morning session of the second day has been started with an awareness programme on "Seasonal Diseases and its preventive measures". Sri. Dr. Mohana Krishna, Govt. Homeopathic Hospital, Chittoor in his talk explained that "Cold, cough and flu in winter, typhoid, malaria and dengue in monsoon, diarrhea in summer are common seasonal occurrences every year. Maintaining a proper immunization program, following hygienic practices, consumption of healthy food and water, and keeping the surroundings clean which do not support the breeding of mosquitoes can help prevent the onset of many seasonal diseases. Smt. K. Manjula, Head Mistress and Sri. A. Hemadri, School teacher, MPPS, P. Kothur gave some tips for healthy living.

Later, a "Three-day Sunstroke and Chickenpox Awareness and Prevention Campaign" was carried out in P. Kothur and Harijanawada. Dr. Mohana Krishna explained about the symptoms, causes for sunstroke and preventive measures to be followed to prevent heatstroke in summer. He also explained the mode of infection, symptoms and control measures for chicken pox. He explained the dosage of preventive homeopathic medicine and precautions to be taken after taking homeopathic medicines to the volunteers. Under the supervision of Dr. Mohana Krishna, NSS volunteers gave the medicine directly to the person and explained the precautions and control measures to be followed. Volunteers have covered all the households by campaigning door to door in the village through distribution of pamphlets on symptoms, causes and preventive measures of heatstroke. During lunch break, the Principal and Academic coordinator of

the college interacted with NSS volunteers about camp arrangements and camp activities.

In the post lunch session, pits were dug by volunteers and ground was made thoroughly ready for plantation. The saplings plantation programme in the adopted village was started by Dr. G. Ananda Reddy, Principal, PVKN Govt. College(A) and Dr. T. Gopla Krishna Reddy, Retd Prof. of Zoology, A.N. University, Guntur through plantation and watering of flowering plants in the adopted village. Awareness Rally on "COVID" Precautions, COVID vaccination and Hand washing" was taken out in P. Kothur and Harijanawada villages to spread awareness about the importance of taking precautionary measures against COVID-19. NSS volunteers interacted with the households in the village and stressed the importance of wearing masks, keeping hands sanitized and getting vaccinated against COVID-19.

In the last session, NSS volunteers planted and watered the flowering plants and pongamia plants along the streets and inside the school premises of P. Kothur. Lastly, the volunteers discussed about the activities to be undertaken for the next day with the camp officer. Volunteers sang the NSS song and concluded the day by NSS clapping.

DAY-4 (18-03-2022)

The fourth day of journey in serving the society through NSS special camping programme began with the distribution of second-dose of Homeopathy medicine to prevent sunstroke and chicken pox directly to the person and covered almost all the households by campaigning door to door in the village.

A free Animal Health Camp (Veterinary Camp) was organized in the adopted village in association with Sri. B.S. Mani, Animal Health Assistant, Grama Sachivalayam, Cherlopalli. Door to door communication was given to the village people by the NSS volunteers to avail the Animal Health Camp. The NSS volunteers played a vital role in making this camp successful with their commitment in gathering cows and calves to the camp. This camp had very good response and around 90 cows and calves from P. Kothur and Harijanawada villages were benefited through Deticking and Deworming. NSS volunteers actively participated in spaying Butox medicine to animals.

Dr. N. Ramamurthy, NSS PO Unit-III, PVKN GC (A), Chittoor has delivered Lecture on "Environmental Protection and Conservation". He enlightened on the process

of waste management and proper utilization of natural resources. He explained about the types of pollution, causes and its consequences like Global warming, Acid rains and Ozone depletion. Lt. A. Ramesh, NCC ANO, PVKN GC (A), Chittoor addressed NSS volunteers on "Youth Leadership". He expressed in his view that NSS special camping programme is one of the platforms for the volunteers to develop their leadership qualities. Thoughts were exchanged on building up of leadership qualities and importance of team spirit. Additional emphasis was given on the role of the individual and steps to be taken in developing leadership qualities. Dr. N. Ramamurthy, A. Ramesh-NCC, Sri Lokesh-PD, PVKN GC (A), Chittoor, Village children, NSS volunteers and Camp officer were involved in cleaning of approach road from highway to the village and also cleaned the premises of bus stop at P. Kothur. They swept the roads and removed plastic waste and dust heaps along with weeds on both sides of road. The blocked sewage in the drainage canals of the streets has been cleared.

In the post lunch session, Awareness Rally was carried out on "Anti-plastic: Harmful effects of single use plastic" in three villages namely P. Kothur Harijanawada, Vengareddy Palli and P. Kothur. During the rally the student volunteers raised slogans against plastic pollution and carried out placards on the concept of 'RRR' (Refuse, Reuse and Recycle Plastic). They interacted with the people in the villages and explained the harmful effects of single use plastic on environment and human health. They sensitized people by showing the substitutes for plastics like cloth bags, steel water bottles etc. They motivated villagers to change their use and throw culture of plastic. The students stressed the need for switching to cloth bags instead of plastic bags. Lastly, the volunteers discussed about the activities to be undertaken for the next day with the camp officer.

DAY-5 (19-03-2022)

In continuation of previous day programme on "Three-Day Sunstroke and Chickenpox Awareness and Prevention Campaign", the NSS Volunteers has given the third dose of Homeopathy medicine directly to the person to prevent chicken pox and Sunstroke by campaigning door to door in the P. Kothur village and Harijanawada. One team of NSS volunteers cleaned the water sump in school premises with liquid bleach. The other team of volunteers watered the planted saplings in the adopted village.

NSS volunteers visited Grama sachivalayam and interacted with all the employees to understand the administration system in the panchayath. Pits were dug by volunteers and ground was made thoroughly ready for plantation near new Sachivalayam premises and MPUP School premises in Cherlopalli village. Volunteers planted Sapling's like pongamia, neem and badam and watered them. Later, one team of NSS volunteers involved in cleaning of overhead tank in Cherlopalli panchayath with liquid bleach. The other team members actively cleaned MPUP School premises in Cherlopalli village by removing plastic waste, paper waste and weeds.

As a part of Swachhata Hi Seva, Camp officer along with the student volunteers cleaned the premises of Grama Sachivalayam in the Cherlopalli village and its surroundings. Weeds, plastic waste and garbage was strewn and cleared away along the roads in Cherlopalli. Sri. K. Bhaskar Reddy, Sarpanch, Cherlopalli Panchayath and Smt. T. Baby, Panchayath Secretary, Cherlopalli Panchayath, Chittoor participated in this Swachhata Hi Seva activity. Awareness Rally was carried out on "Anti-plastic: Harmful effects of single use plastic" in Cherlopalli village. During the rally the student volunteers raised slogans against plastic pollution and carried placards on harmful effects of single use plastics. They sensitized people by showing the substitutes for plastics like cloth bags, steel water bottles etc.

In the afternoon session, strengths and weaknesses analysis session was carried out by the camp officer. Knowing one's own strengths and weaknesses gives them a better understanding about themselves and how they function. NSS volunteers are instructed to list out their strengths and weaknesses and present it for discussion with camp officer. Understanding their strengths enabled them to aim higher and achieve much more. Knowing weaknesses helped in understanding of things that holds them back. Dr. P. Bhanuprakash suggested NSS volunteers to work on their weaknesses and find ways where they don't hinder you.

Lastly, with a concept of Health is Wealth a guest lecture was organized on "Health and Healthy Lifestyle". Dr. T. Hari Babu, Coordinator, M.Sc Chemistry, PVKN GC (A), Chittoor addressed the volunteers and children of the village and explained the importance of the healthy life style. He suggested that the habit of choosing unhealthy snacks, junk food or spending our free time by watching TV will negatively impact our life style. He suggested that by following good food habits and daily

physical activity everyone can lead a healthy life. Sri. O. Hariprasad, Lecturer in Chemistry, PVKN GC (A), Chittoor suggested few ways to lead a healthy lifestyle such as drinking plenty of water, preferably eating more fruits and vegetables, switching off the TV and computer screen and getting active through playing physical games and eating less snacks. Volunteers discussed about the activities to be undertaken for the next day with the camp officer.

DAY-6 (20-03-2022)

The sixth day of journey in serving the society through camp began with training on "Yoga and Pranayamam". Dr. Mohano Behera, State best NSS PO awardee, Yoga Master explained and created awareness on Yoga and its benefits. He explained that "Yoga is a practice that connects the body, mind, and soul through different body postures, meditation, and controlled breathing. Yoga postures and pranayamam are a holistic fitness package which improves health, physical strength and gives mental strength". He gave training on different yoga asanas including suryanamaskaram and pranayamam which aims at developing mental and physical fitness and relieving from stress through regular practice. The children of the village, NSS volunteers and Camp officer have been actively practiced different Yoga asanas and pranayamam.

Later, NSS volunteers interacted with school going children and their parents in P. Kothur ST colony and analysed the reasons for the school dropouts. The main reasons for dropout are found to be (i) parents are migrant workers or daily laborers with less financial resources and they want their child to contribute financially, (ii) lack of interest in studies among children and (iii) too much freedom in their community. Camp officer and volunteers counselled the school dropout children and also the children who are irregular to the school by explaining the benefits that are provided by the Government of Andhra Pradesh to the school going children like reimbursement of school fees through (Amma vodi scheme), mid-day meals, distribution of school kits including bags, books, uniform, shoes etc at free of cost. The Camp officer and volunteers explained the importance of education in upliftment of one's family in all areas and motivated the dropouts towards the school.

As a part of sightseeing, NSS volunteers have done hill trekking to explore the majestic beauty of a hill situated near P. Kothur ST colony. The students enjoyed the scenery and the beauty of natural environment. Later, volunteers visited a nearby PVKN GC (A), CHITTOOR NSS UNIT-I

watermelon farm which is grown using the technique of mulching. They understood that mulching technique helps in conservation of soil moisture, reducing the growth of weeds and improving the fertility of the soil.

Awareness Rally was carried out on "Anti-plastic: Harmful effects of single use plastic" and "COVID vaccination" in P. Kothur ST colony. The Camp officer along with the student volunteers removed left out pooja materials such as used flowers, broken coconut pieces and water sachets in the premises of temple near P. Kothur ST colony. The surroundings of the temple were also cleaned by removing the weeds, grass and plastic left outs.

In the afternoon session, Dr. C. Meerasaheb, Vice-Principal, PVKN GC (A), Chittoor interacted with the volunteers and children of village on "Goal setting". He suggested the students to "Dream Big, Set Goals and Take Action". He interacted with every student and inquired about their goals and action plan to achieve it. He advised to set SMART (specific, measurable, attainable, relevant, and time-bound) goals and then commit to it. It was an interactive session for the student volunteers and they actively involved in the discussion.

A field visit to mango tree propagation field has been arranged to volunteers in P. Kothur village. In live, an expert in grafting technique explained the method of mango tree propagation via grafting to the volunteers. They understood the role of healthy rootstock and scions in the mango grafting method. They understood how to graft a mano tree and other pertinent information of this technique.

As a part of physical activity, volley ball game was conducted for NSS volunteers. All the volunteers were actively participated in the game. In the evening, Lemon and spoon game and running race followed by singing and dancing competition was conducted by volunteers for children in the adopted village. We distributed prizes to winners and consolation prizes to all participants in the games and cultural competition. Volunteers also sang songs, and performed dance to entertain the children and villagers. Finally, volunteers discussed about the activities to be undertaken for the last day in the camp with camp officer and concluded the day by NSS clapping.

DAY-7 (21-03-2022)

The last day of the NSS Special Camping programme began with watering of planted saplings in the village. The village people were asked to water the saplings and take care of them. NSS volunteers had put in lot of efforts and decorated school campus with Rangoli, which is a traditional way to express their imaginative skills. On the last session, each NSS volunteer selected one school student and revised the basics of their curriculum. It enable the volunteers to develop their teaching skills.

Valedictory Ceremony:

Volunteers have made all the required arrangements for the valedictory function. Dr. G. Ananda Reddy, Principal, PVKN Govt. College (A), Chittoor presided over the function. Sri. K. Bhaskar Reddy, Sarpanch, P. Kothur, Cherlopalli Panchayath, attended the programme as Chief Guest. Smt. T. Baby, Panchayath Secretary, Cherlopalli Panchayath and Smt. K. Manjula, Head Mistress, MPPS, P. and Sri Ravikanth, A.O, PVKN Govt. College (A), Chittoor is the special invitee for the valedictory function. Representatives from the village, teaching and non-teaching staff of the college, Grama volunteers, School children, Village youth and volunteers have attended the function.

Camp Officer Sri P. Bhanuprakash addressed the gathering and submitted report on various service activities undertaken during their 7 days of Special Camping Programme in the village. Dr. G. Ananda Reddy, Principal appreciated the Volunteers for their community work and thanked the village authorities for their support. The guests of honour profusely thanked the volunteers and camp officer and the authorities of the college for their dedicated community activities in the panchayath. They assured all sorts of co-operation in their future operations in the adopted village. The special invitee in his address emphasized that the Camping Programmes of this kind will definitely help the volunteers in their personality development.

The chief guest in his address appreciated the NSS Volunteers for utilizing the opportunities provided by the camp for group living, collective experience sharing and constant interaction with community. He expressed that the purpose of the camp was served in inculcating social, cultural, moral, educational and ethical values among volunteers. He motivated the students to do better and continuous services to the

society. The volunteers in teams have shared their experiences in the camp. Miss Sharmila-NSS volunteer proposed vote of thanks to the villagers, school children, Head Mistress of the MPP School, P.Kothur for their support and encouragement. She also thanked all the dignitaries, guests, teaching and non-teaching staff for their esteemed presence. The camp has been concluded with National Anthem.

Concluding remarks:

All these seven days, the special camp followed a good discipline and managed the time systematically. Volunteers learned how-to live-in society and communicate with their fellow members. The camp also helped the NSS volunteers to enrich the creative aspect of their personality with high morale and self-confidence. The experience they had in the camp will last long and will guide them for the rest of their future.
