Sapling plantations are not only beneficial to the environment but are also crucial in the growing worries of climate change as the trees are considered as the natural purifiers of the Earth. The students who are carrying out internships at different industries and community service projects at different places are motivated to plant saplings at their workplaces.



Report:

SUICIDE PREVENTION AND AWARENESS PROGRAMME 16-09-2023

Suicide is a major public health problem with far-reaching social, emotional and economic consequences. It is estimated that there are currently more than 7,00,000 suicides per year worldwide, and we know that each suicide profoundly affects many more people. World Suicide Prevention is an awareness day observed on 10th September every year, to provide commitment and action to prevent suicides, with various activities.

The NSS unit of the college organizes a suicide prevention and awareness programme on 16th September 2023 in the Botany lab of the college. Dr A. Sudharshan-NCD Program officer Chittoor (Dist) explained about the suicide myths and facts to the students and volunteers of the college.

Myth - suicide happens without a warning

Fact - almost everyone who commits suicide has given some clue or warning- you just missed it

Myth - people who attempt suicide really want to die

Fact- rather than wanting to die, they just wanted the pain to stop. Maybe you could have helped them to stop.

Myth - people who can talk about suicide really won't do it

Fact- Talking about suicide can be a plea for help and it can be a sign in the progression towards a suicide attempt.

Myth- people who die by suicide are unwilling to seek help, they actually want to die.

Fact- more than 50% of the suicide victims try to get help before attempting suicide. Even a severely depressed person has mixed feelings about death, fluctuating between wanting to live and wanting to die.

Myth - all suicide individuals are mentally ill

Fact- most of the suicidal people are not psychotic or insane. They are upset, griefstricken, despaired and extremely distressed.

Myth-talking about suicide may give someone the idea.

Fact- you don't give suicidal ideas to someone by talking about suicide. Rather talking openly and honestly about suicidal thoughts and feelings can save a life.

Dr P. Uday Kiran, Psychiatrist, District Mental Health Program Officer addressed the volunteers and students about "the signs and recognition of suicide behavior, prevention of suicide and how to respond quickly if a suicide attempt seems imminent (dial 14416)". L. Srivani District Epidomolgy Officer and S. Yasin Raja Psychiatric Social worker, Mental Health Program also interacted with the students. Dr. C. Meera Saheb, Vice-Principal, P. Bhanuprakash-NSS PO, faculty members, 60 students of the college participated in the awareness activity.

FREE HEMOGLOBIN TEST CAMP

(16-09-2023)

A free hemoglobin (Hb) testing camp is organized by NSS unit of the college with the help of the Accredited Social Health Activist (ASHA) of Greamspet ward on 16th September, 2023 in the Chemistry wing of the college that remedial measures can be taken to improve their hemoglobin levels.

Blood samples of 70 girl students studying I-year are collected and hemoglobin tests are performed by the ASHA workers. After diagnosis, the students with low percentages of hemoglobin were suggested to use Iron and folic acid supplements to improve their hemoglobin levels. Iron and folic acid supplements were dispensed free of cost by our NSS Volunteers under the supervision of ASHA team. Students were counseled by NSS Volunteers regarding dietary intake to be followed to improve their hemoglobin levels. Dr. P. Bhanuprakash- NSS Programme officer and NSS volunteers have been actively involved in the free hemoglobin (Hb) camp.






NATIONAL UNITY DAY









NEW VOTER ENROLLMENT PROCESS (28-11-2023)&(29-11-2023)




VOTER AWARENESS RALLY






