




WORLD WATER DAY-SAVE WATER SAVE LIFE (21-03-2023)





WORLD SUICIDE PREVENTION DAY

(08-09-2022)

World Suicide Prevention Day (WSPD) was established in 2003 by the International Association for Suicide Prevention in association with the World Health Organization (WHO). The 10th of September each year focuses attention on the issue, reduces stigma and raises awareness among organizations, and the public, giving a message that suicide can be prevented. "Creating hope through action" is the theme for the WSPD from 2021 - 2023. This theme reminds us that there is an alternative to suicide and aims to inspire confidence and light in all of us.



On 8th September 2022, the NSS units of our college observed World Nature Conservation Day in association with the Women Empowerment Cell at the Chemistry Seminar Hall to create awareness among students against suicides. Removing the stigma attached to suicides and making people recognize the warning signs of a suicidal person are critical components of the awareness programme.

Smt. Naga Sowjanya, Sub Inspector of Police, Disha women police station, Chittoor addressed the students that most suicides are due to psychiatric diseases. While anxiety is a normal phenomenon in most people, with specific individuals, the degree of anxiety increases the disorder's level. Many types of anxiety and phobia-related disorders can trigger suicide tendency.

Dr. P. Bhanuprakash, NSS Programme officer administered a pledge among students and staff to support suicide prevention. Dr. A. Sasikala and Smt P. Hemalatha-Women Empowerment Cell addressed the students and emphasized that suicide is a major preventable cause of premature death. Coping with anxiety, communicating more with people, taking self-care, being physically active, and practising yoga and meditation are few tips to reduce anxiety and deal with suicidal thoughts. Dr. T. Hari Babu and Sri O. Hari Prasad-Lecturer in Chemistry also participated in the awareness programme.

AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON DENGUE

(17-10-2022)

On 17th October 2022, NSS Volunteers of PVKN Govt. College (A), Chittoor involved in creating awareness on Dengue. They distributed posters related to causes, symptoms, preventive and Control measures of Dengue.

Dengue is a disease transmitted by the bite of infected Aedes mosquito and caused by virus. Dengue fever causes flu-like symptoms, such as-high temperature (fever)-severe headache- muscle and joint pain-facial flushing and skin rashes. NSS volunteers suggested the following measures to control dengue:

Mosquito Control: Reduce mosquito breeding sites by eliminating standing water in containers, using mosquito nets, and employing insecticides.

Protective Clothing: Wear long-sleeved shirts and long pants to minimize skin exposure to mosquitoes.

Mosquito Repellents: Use insect repellents on exposed skin and clothing.

Window and Door Screens: Ensure windows and doors are screened to prevent mosquitoes from entering living spaces.

Avoid Peak Mosquito Activity: Aedes mosquitoes, the primary vectors of Dengue, are most active during early morning and late afternoon. Take precautions during these times.







ANTI-DRUGS CAMPAIGN THROUGH STICKERS IN THE COLLEGE (21-01-2023)

Objectives of organizing the National Youth Parliament Festival:


- To hear the voice of youth between 18-25 years of age, through deliberations in Youth Parliaments at District, State and National levels.

FREE HEMOGLOBIN TEST CAMP

(14-02-2023)

A hemoglobin (Hb) test measures the levels of hemoglobin in the blood. Hemoglobin is a protein in the red blood cells that carries oxygen from your lungs to the rest of your body. A hemoglobin test is often used to check for anemia, a condition in which one's body has fewer red blood cells than normal. If one has anemia, the cells in body don't get all the oxygen need resulting in weakness, fatigue, dizziness and trouble breathing. Hemoglobin deficiency is found to be one of the major reasons for various diseases among girls and women. Hence, free hemoglobin (Hb) testing camp is organized by NSS unit of the college with the help of the Accredited Social Health Activist (ASHA) of Greamspet ward on 14th February, 2023 in the Chemistry wing of the college that remedial measures can be taken to improve their hemoglobin levels.

The hemoglobin (Hb) test camp was inaugurated by Dr. G. Ananda Reddy, Principal, PVKN Govt. College (A), Chittoor. A total of 170 girl students and 40 teaching staff blood samples are collected and hemoglobin tests are performed by the ASHA workers. After diagnosis, the students with low percentages of hemoglobin were suggested to use Iron and folic acid supplements to improve their hemoglobin levels. Iron and folic acid supplements were dispensed free of cost by our NSS Volunteers under the supervision of ASHA team. Students were counseled by NSS Volunteers regarding dietary intake to be followed to improve their hemoglobin levels.

HANDSONTRAININGONCARDIOPULMONARYRESUSCITATION (CPR)(20-02-2023 & 25-02-2023)

On 20th February 2023 and 25th February 2023, a workshop on "Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation" has been organized by National Service Scheme of P.V.K.N. Govt. College (A), Chittoor in association with the Apollo College of Nursing Chittoor, Apollo Institute of Medical Sciences and Research, Chittoor. The objective of the training programme is to enhance the knowledge and skills on basic life support (BLS) and to increase the competency and capability of degree students adequately for the management of cardio pulmonary emergencies.

Welcome address was delivered by Dr. P. Bhanu Prakash, Lecturer in Chemistry and NSS programme organizer. Dr. G. Ananda Reddy, Principal, PVKN Govt. College (A), Chittoor addressed the gathering with a key note on the importance of CPR training. Mrs. P. Anusha, Asst. Professor, Apollo College of Nursing, Chittoor (ACONC) oriented the students about the importance, indications and purposes of BLS, followed by division of students into groups. Each group was allotted to one faculty trainer from ACONC to give hands-on training about BLS. After thorough training, each student was asked to present the same skill by demonstration. In total 250 students have been trained on CPR by the 9 members team of Apollo nursing faculty. Dr. N. Ramamurthy-NSS Programme officer, Ms. Amrutha ANM, NSS volunteers, students of PVKN participated in the workshop on "Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation".

TUBERCULOSIS AWARENESS PROGRAMME

(25-02-2023)

Tuberculosis disease (TB) is a highly infectious pulmonary disease characterized by a prolonged cough, chest pain, weakness or fatigue, weight loss, fever and night sweats. The disease is mainly caused by the bacterium Mycobacterium tuberculosis (M. tuberculosis) in humans and can be lethal if left untreated. On 25th February 2023, Tuberculosis (TB) awareness programme was organized by the NSS unit of PVKN Govt. College (A), Chittoor in the college auditorium to spread awareness on TB to the students and staff members.

The main speaker of the TB awareness program is Sri S. Mohana Prasad, District Tuberculosis Centre (DTC)-Senior Treatment Supervisor (STS) Chittoor. He briefly explained about the early symptoms, modes of tuberculosis transmission, identification of tuberculosis suspects and finally about the prevention of tuberculosis through power point presentation. He appealed the college students to spread awareness on TB to their family members, friends, neighbours and the entire village to execute the slogan as "TB Harega Des Geetega" to end TB. He also spoke on TB treatment facilities provided at the doorstep, by the health department and appealed to the needy to avail these facilities. He also explained about the importance of Directly Observed Treatment (DOTS), tuberculosis control strategy recommended by the World Health Organization. His team also distributed pamphlets indicating causes, symptoms and treatment for TB. 200 students and staff utilized the programme. Dr. P. Bhanuprakash, NSS PO appreciated the DTC-STS and his team for organizing the awareness activity on Tuberculosis and its control in the college. He also appealed to the audience to convey the message to their parents and friends.
