Fellowships: The financial aid awarded to the individuals willing to pursue research on a specific subject after they qualify prescribed test/ range of activities including graduate study in a specific field of research, advance work on a particular issue. UG advanced Learners who are pursuing student research project are eligible. The PG 2nd year students who qualified state level APRESCET, UGC NET/ SLET, and it applies to the students who are admitted into Ph.D programs as a measure of strengthening research programs in the college. After assessing the student progress of work by the Research evaluation committee, the above assistance is provided from respective PG course fund.

Medals: Gold medals/- Philanthropists, Alumni, CPDC.

Prizes : Endowment/- Philanthropists, Alumni, CPDC.

Certificates- Appreciation-Academic-Excellence / Curricular / Extracurricular / community relevant, local need based Research the students who show outstanding performance-Faculty-Industry Experts-Alumni.
